
Timelines

- Sutori is an online collaborative tool that allows teachers and students to create customized interactive timelines containing information, images, videos and hyperlinks to websites. The tool enables the integration of multiple choice and/or matching questions, which give a more interactive character to the presentation.



TimelineJS

- TimelineJS (https://timeline.knightlab.com/)
- It is a web-based (free and open-source software) application through which one can create impressive interactive timelines via Google Docs.

- This is a free online tool that allows for impressive, non-linear projection of our slides. With this tool we can also create timelines through the timeline template..
- ReadWriteThink (http://www.readwritethink.org)
- Teachers and students have the opportunity to create graphical representation of an event or process by sequencing the events. Timelines can be organized by time period, date or event. The tool allows for text and image input.
- myHistro (<u>http://www.myhistro.com/</u>)
- This is a web-based application for creating timelines with simultaneous display of maps. The application enables the association of entries with locations in Google Earth and viewing them in a continuous stream

Thinglink for Higher Education






Concept maps

 Conceptual maps, also known as mind maps or association diagrams, are graphical tools used to visualise and organise ideas, concepts, data and the relationships between them. These maps are a powerful tool for education and can improve comprehension, learning and memory, as well as facilitate creative thinking and planning.



Examples of web tools for Concept maps •



- Cmap: has a useful set of tools that allow users to create complex conceptual maps in different styles and colours. In addition, the software offers sharing and collaboration features, allowing multiple users to work on a concept map at the same time.
- <u>Coggle</u>: a simple and easy-to-use application for creating concept maps, which allows users to share their maps with others.
- Mindomo: a flexible and easy-to-use tool that helps users organise their ideas, develop connections and visualise complex information in a structured way.
- <u>Lucidchart:</u> although best known for creating flowcharts and graphs, Lucidchart also provides capabilities for creating conceptual maps

Powerpoint Presentations -Tips



Avoid using pictures as backgrounds, as they can make it difficult to read the texts.



Avoid putting too much information on a slide. Use no more than two types of fonts, with the first for the title and the other for text.



Use clear, legible fonts, such as Arial, Calibri, and Tahoma.



Choose appropriate font sizes, preferably 14-point font sizes that are suitable for visually impaired users.



Avoid using italics for emphasis; instead, use boldface or underlining.



Ensure that illustrations are in sharp focus and consider the quality of the images.
